Summer Enrichment and Summer Fun Details:

The ESBOCES Summer Enrichment and Summer Fun Programs are available to all students who are entering Grades 1 through Grade 8 in September 2024.

Summer Enrichment – There will be three (3), two-week sessions from July 8, 2024 – August 16, 2024.

Summer Enrichment is full-day or a half-day program.

Summer Fun – There will be 7 weeks to choose from beginning on July 1, 2024 (closed on July 4th and 5th) and ending on August 16, 2024.

Summer Fun is a full-day program.

Additional Important Program Details:

- Summer Enrichment and Summer Fun will take place at Boyle Road Elementary School, 424 Boyle Road, Port Jefferson Station.
- Students will be bused to the Brookhaven Town Centereach Pool 1 day a week for swimming; the day of week is to be determined.
- **Snacks and Lunch:**
Parents must provide all lunch, snacks and drinks for their children.

Program Activities

STEAM Enrichment Courses:

Hands-on STEAM activities are designed to make ALL students get excited about the world around them. Sample programs included: Drones, Oceanic Exploration, Claymation, Makey Makey, Green Screen, Genetics, Famous Architecture Around the World, and Unleash Your Wild Side.

Literacy Courses:

Students will participate in small groups specifically designed to develop literacy skills and engage students in their learning. Students should have fun as they design and author their own creative works. Sample programs included: Cooking-Up-Even-More Stories, Enchanted STEAM Fairy Tales, Book Creator, Mock Trial, Observing Ozobots, Ornithology, Video Production and Survivor.

Reading Adventures - Reading for All:

Students will explore a wide variety of texts by participating in small reading groups at their instructional levels and will become involved in activities related to their reading. Reading Adventures will use fiction and non-fiction to engage students as they learn how reading can expand their world. For more experienced readers at higher grade levels, we will do a Reader's Theatre style literacy offering.

Field Trips (anticipated to occur):

Field trips will be offered as an option to all half-day and full-day students, and the cost is included in the tuition. The in-person field trips are an Arts and Education on-site Assembly, Long Island Ducks Game, Splish Splash, and Top Golf. A parent/guardian may opt out of any scheduled field trip offered this year.

Summer Fun and Learning Program:

Art Expression - Students will experiment with drawing, jewelry making, painting and arts and crafts.

Recreational Games - Students will be grouped according to age and participate in basketball, soccer, football and other sports. Students will learn team play, fitness and sportsmanship.

Story Hour - Students will build literacy skills through independent reading and read-alouds. Students will be provided with opportunities to write their own plays and stories.

Summer Fun Important Details:

The ESBOCES Summer Fun Program is a Full-day program available to all students who are entering Grades 1 through Grade 8 in September 2024.

Summer Fun is a 7 week program starting on July 1, 2024 and ending on August 16, 2024 (closed on July 4th and 5th).

You may register your child for the entire 7 weeks or choose the weeks they will attend.

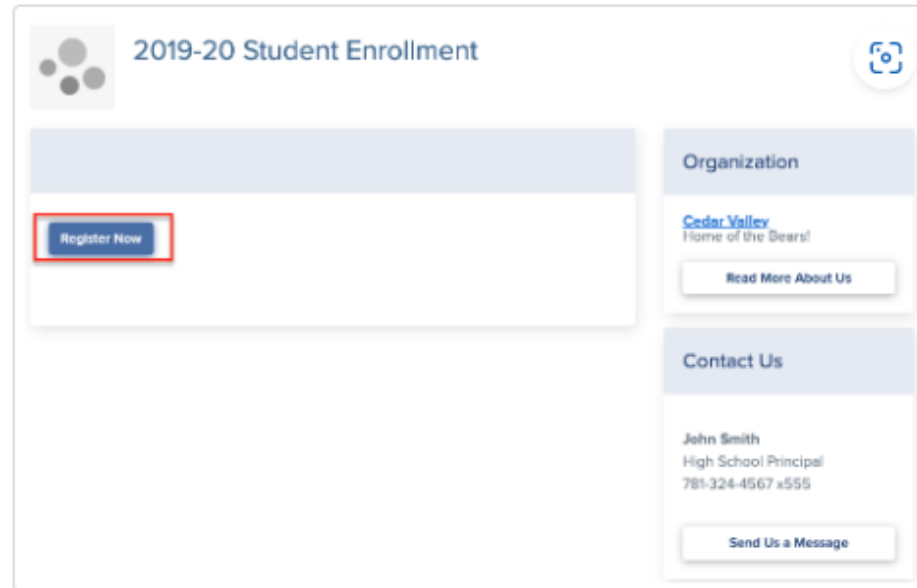


