



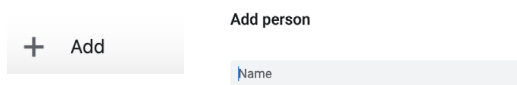
USING AND MANAGING GOOGLE CHROME PROFILES

What is a Google Chrome Profile?

A Google Chrome Profile is different than a Google Account. A profile in Chrome is used to access essential items such as bookmarks, and to keep personal, work and school accounts separate from one another.

Creating a Google Chrome Profile

- 1 Open Google Chrome on your desktop computer / device.
- 2 Click the Profile icon in the top right corner (next to the three dots).
- 3 Click the “+ Add” button to begin the process of creating a Chrome profile. Assign a name & image for your profile.



Logging In to an Existing Profile

- 1 Open Google Chrome on your desktop computer / device.
- 2 Click the Profile icon in the top right corner (next to the three dots), and then click “Sign In to Chrome.”
- 3 Sign in with your Google Account credentials. We recommend signing in to one account per Chrome profile.

Syncing Data to a Google Chrome Profile

In the “Manage Profile” section of Chrome, where you created Chrome profiles, you can turn on the profile sync where you can automatically update data such as bookmarks across multiple devices at once. This ensures that no matter what computer you are using Chrome on, you can still access the same bookmarks.

Signing Out of Chrome

To sign out of Google Chrome, go to Manage Profile > Sign Out. If you have turned Sync on, you can turn it off. This will also log you out of any Google accounts you are currently signed in to. Sync will resume the next time you log in to your Chrome profile.
